Americans with Disabilities Act
(ADA) and Transportation
Disadvantaged Programs**

Both the ADA and TD programs are door-to-door, shared ride transportation services for individuals with a physician verified ADA disability that prevents the use of the Palm Tran bus system. Individuals must complete an eligibility application.

Transportation is provided to any destination within the ADA Service Area for \$3 per one way trip. Service operates 7 days a week and is wheelchair accessible.

ADA Service Area: In Palm Beach County between Donald Ross road and county's southern border and east of the Turnpike. Service is also available to any area within 3/4 of a mile of a Palm Tran bus.

Transportation Disadvantaged Program: Provides transportation for medical, adult day care, food shopping, meal sites, employment, and educational trips anywhere in Palm Beach County that is outside the ADA Service Area.

TD Bus Pass Program: Individuals earning less than \$16,245 a year can receive a 31 day unlimited bus pass for \$5. Applications are at 3044 S. Military Trail, Lake Worth, FL 33463 or call (561) 649-9838. A photo I.D. and proof of income (Social Security, Income Tax, Retirement/Pension, Unemployment or 2 Pay Stubs) is required.

Reduced Bus Fare: For Seniors 65+, Veterans, Medicare recipients, and ADA disabled.

Single Ride	\$0.75	\$1.50
One day unlimited pass	\$2.75	\$4.00
31 day unlimited pass	\$45.00	\$60.00

Buses are wheelchair accessible. A bus rider's guide with schedules, maps, and eligibility information are on the buses or call (561) 841-4287.

FEDERATION TRANSPORTATION

Federation transportation is offered to seniors in Boca Raton, Delray and Highland Beach to access specified meal sites at no charge and medical appointments for \$3 each way (reduced rate for those who qualify). Vehicles are shared ride, wheelchair accessible and operate Monday - Friday from 8 am to 5 pm. Registration is required.

VOLEN CENTER TRANSPORTATION

Volen Center transportation is for seniors living between Hypoluxo Road and the county's southern border. Fares are \$3 each way with medical and senior dining site trips provided for a donation. Vehicles are shared ride, wheelchair accessible and operate Monday - Friday from 7:30 am to 6 pm. Registration is required.

MEDICAID TRANSPORTATION

For Medicaid recipients without access to medical appointments (including trips out-side Palm Beach County) for a \$1 fare each way. Vehicles are shared ride, wheelchair accessible and operate Monday - Friday from 6 am to 6 pm. Registration is required.

TRAIN & CITY SHUTTLES

Tri-rail Train: Serves the east coast of Palm Beach, Broward, and Miami/Dade including shuttle connections to airports. Trains operate 7 days a week and are wheelchair accessible. Fare is based on trip distance and day of week: Seniors 65+ pay half price. 1-800-874-7245 or www.Tri-Rail.com

West Palm Beach: A free trolley connects City Place to Clematis Street District. Call (561) 838-9511 or www.mollystrolleys.com
